

FRIDAY // MADE NEW THROUGH GENEROSITY

Pray about your role in the MADE NEW building project. Ask God for wisdom, faith, and joy as you consider your gift.

“God, help me give with gladness. Shape me into a generous person. Free me from fear, scarcity, and control. Teach me to trust You as I help make this vision a reality.”

2 Corinthians 9:10 // For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you.

SATURDAY// MADE NEW IN ALL THINGS

Pray big prayers. Pray for infinitely more than we might ask or think. Worship God for being the One who makes all things new, and surrender the future to Him.

“Jesus, align my heart with Your kingdom. Teach me to hope for renewal beyond what I can see and to trust You as You make all things new.”

Isaiah 43:19 // For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it? I will make a pathway through the wilderness. I will create rivers in the dry wasteland.

28-DAY PRAYER CHALLENGE

Prayer isn't the thing we do before the work. Prayer is the work.

From February 22 to March 21, our church family will be praying together. Jesus taught us that new wine requires new wineskins. If old clothes are patched with new fabric, the patch will tear. When God renews us, God prepares us to receive what only He can pour out.

Revelation 21:5 says, *"Look, I am making everything new."*

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Each of the four weeks follows the same daily prayer focus. Pray daily. Pray honestly. Pray boldly. Repeat this pattern for four weeks until our Giving Sunday on March 22.

SUNDAY // MADE NEW IN ME

Pray for your own heart. Ask God to renew your faith, motives, obedience, and trust. Invite the Holy Spirit to make you new and shape you into the image of Jesus.

"God, make me new. Renew my desires, my trust, and my obedience. Make me open and ready for the new work You want to accomplish in me and through me."

2 Corinthians 5:17 // This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

MONDAY // MADE NEW IN KIDS AND FAMILIES

Pray for Carbondale Kids and ArkPark: our children, our leaders, and our families. Pray that our Sunday morning opportunities, Girls Ministries, Royal Rangers, and Junior Bible Quiz will make disciples who make disciples like never before.

"God, form the next generation in Your love and truth. Use our church to create spaces where faith can take deep root and grow mightily."

Matthew 19:14 // But Jesus said, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them! For the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to those who are like these children."

TUESDAY // MADE NEW IN YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS

Pray for Carbondale Youth and Carbondale Young Adults. Pray for our student leaders and adult sponsors. Pray for our school Bible studies, Life Groups, Teen Bible Quiz and every effort to make disciples who make disciples.

"Jesus, shape our students and young adults into disciples who know who they are in You. Form their faith to last, even in the hardest of seasons."

Proverbs 22:6 // Train up a child in the way he should go, and even when he is old he will not depart from it.

WEDNESDAY // MADE NEW IN CHURCH COMMUNITY

Pray for Sunday Groups, Life Groups, Women's Groups, Men's Groups, and every opportunity for people to connect at Carbondale. Pray for our leaders. Pray for unity, humility, and love across our church family.

"Father, form us into a united church. Shape our relationships, our leadership, and our service so we reflect Jesus together."

Romans 12:4-5 // Just as our bodies have many parts and each part has a special function, so it is with Christ's body. We are many parts of one body, and we all belong to each other.

THURSDAY // MADE NEW IN TULSA

Pray for our city, neighbors, schools, and workplaces. Pray for our Carbondale leaders who serve faithfully in schools, retirement homes, community centers, recovery programs and prisons. Let our church be a place of hope and healing for the Tulsa area.

"God, form our church into a faithful presence in our city. Use us to engage adventurously and generously in the global mission of Christ."
